The African Green City Index measures the environmental performance of 15 major African cities. All cities are scored on the basis of 25 quantitative and qualitative indicators across eight environmental categories: energy and CO₂, land use, transport, waste, water, sanitation, air quality and environmental governance.

This chart shows selected indicators for all 15 Index cities.
