Anton S. Huber (born 1951) has been CEO of Siemens Industry Automation Division since January 1, 2008.

Anton S. Huber began his career at Siemens in the Semiconductors Group in 1979. After assuming various allround and staff positions, he took over a leading position in the acquisition of Bendix Electronics and its subsequent integration in the Siemens Automotive LP in the United States in 1989. In 1991, Huber became President and CEO of Siemens Automotive LP, then took over as head of the Motor Vehicle Air Conditioning Systems Division in Rodach/Bavaria. In 1996, he took over as head of Process Automation and Instrumentation Division of the Siemens Automation and Drives (A&D) Group. Huber has headed the integration of the Westinghouse unit for conventional power stations, which was acquired by Siemens, in the Power Generation Group (KWU). Since October 1999 Huber has been Vice President of A&D. He has been responsible for development and production, as well as for developing the business in Asia and the Pacific.
